We hope this letter finds you well! The 2020-2021 season at HCT was a challenge, to say the least. The decisions to postpone shows again and again due to mandatory shutdowns, and ultimately to cancel the remainder of the season line-up, were incredibly difficult. However, "behind-the-scenes" plans to open as soon as possible never stopped. We made lemonade from lemons: the unexpected downtime provided the opportunity to evaluate and prepare for when we would reopen. Your board of directors and membership alike have worked tirelessly to keep theatre alive at HCT.

In December 2020, the stage lights sprang to life as we emerged from the state mandated lockdowns with an online show called *Christmas at HCT* that featured some of the best of HCT talent. Additionally, we were able to finally hit the main stage with *The Odd Couple, Female Version* in July 2021. Like a caterpillar emerging from the darkness of its cocoon, our cast brought energy and life to our previously darkened stage. Our membership welcomed the show with overwhelming attendance and appreciation for the efforts of so many. As we performed to a sold-out show, smiles and laughter filled the house. **We were back... and so were you!**

Over the years, we have continued to maintain and improve HCT by upgrading the house with new seats, repairing a crumbling façade, and installing a digital marquee. We are pleased to announce that during this past season, we applied for and were awarded a federal grant in the amount \$65,700 to be used to improve the physical building. We look forward to using these funds to renovate the dressing room. Plans are in progress to modernize and improve it to meet the needs of our cast and crew and while meeting state mandates including ADA requirements. Our goal is to continue to build upon the foundations set by those who have served HCT before us and prepare for the future of those who will serve HCT when we eventually pass the torch.

In 40 seasons, from our first show in the summer of 1982 to our most recent show this past summer, HCT has continued to meet and exceed the expectations of our membership and the community that we serve while remaining steadfast in our commitment to offer outstanding quality live entertainment and opportunities to showcase your creative talents. We look forward to seeing you soon as you take your seats, watch the house lights fade, and "Places!" is joyfully shouted backstage.






BIG FISH THE MUSICAL - October 14-17, 21-24, 2021


A CHRISTMAS CAROL - December 2-5, 9-12, 2021


THE LION, THE WITCH, AND THE WARDROBE April 21-24, 28-30, May 1, 2022

In collaboration with Habersham Central High School, HCT will present *The Drowsy Chaperone*, a loving send-up of the Jazz Age musical featuring one show-stopping song and dance number after another. With the houselights down, a man in a chair appears on stage and puts on his favorite record: the cast recording of a fictitious 1928 musical. The recording comes to life, with two lovers on the eve of their wedding, a bumbling best man, a desperate theatre producer, a not-so-bright hostess, two gangsters posing as pastry chefs, a misguided Don Juan, and an intoxicated chaperone. This is the stuff of legends... or at least an evening of madcap delight. This production will be shown at the HCHS theater and will not be part of our season ticket offering (separate tickets will be needed to attend this event).
