 <p><b>The Addams Family</b> A NEW MUSICAL COMEDY</p>	<p><b>THE ADDAMS FAMILY – October 12-16, 19-23, 2022</b>  <i>The Addams Family</i> is a comical feast that embraces the wackiness in every family. It's every father's nightmare: Wednesday Addams, the ultimate princess of darkness, has fallen in love with a sweet, smart young man from a respectable family— a man her parents have never met. She confides in her father and begs him not to tell her mother but keeping a secret from his beloved wife, Morticia, is something Gomez has never done before. This is high comedy that shows that the neglected virtues of kindness and affection have not been entirely lost in a world that seems motivated at times only by greed and dishonesty.</p>
<p><b>PRINCE CASPIAN</b></p>	<p><b>PRINCE CASPIAN – April 12-16, 19-23, 2023</b>  <i>Prince Caspian</i> is the second in a collection of stories called "The Chronicles of Narnia." <i>Prince Caspian</i> continues the story of the four Pevensie children, who discovered the land of Narnia after walking through a magical wardrobe in the first of the series, "The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe," and now return to the land of Narnia to help the rightful king and heir, Prince Caspian, take the throne! The intense action features chases, duels, and escapes as Caspian's usurping Uncle Miraz struggles to maintain his hold on Narnia while the sleeping land awaits Aslan's return.</p>

But he's not prepared for the rigorous local edicts, including a ban on dancing instituted by the local preacher, who is determined to exercise control over the town's youth. When his daughter sets her sights on Ren, her boyfriend tries to sabotage Ren's reputation, with the locals eager to believe the worst. The heartfelt story that emerges pins a father longing for the son he lost against a young man aching for the father who walked out on him. <i>Footloose</i> celebrates the wisdom of listening to young people while guiding them with a warm heart and open mind.</p>
