

	<p><b>THE SPITFIRE GRILL – September 30–October 4, 7-11, 2026</b></p> <p>In the small town of Gilead, Wisconsin, recently released parolee Percy Talbott arrives seeking a fresh start. She takes a job at the struggling Spitfire Grill, where her quiet determination begins to impact the lives of those around her. As Percy forms unexpected connections with the town’s residents, long-held secrets and past hurts come to the surface, leading to a moving story about redemption, community, and the power of second chances.</p>
	<p><b>SHE LOVES ME – DECEMBER 2-6, 9-13, 2026</b></p> <p>In a 1920s perfume shop, coworkers Georg and Amalia can’t stand each other, but secretly fall in love as anonymous pen pals. When Georg discovers the truth, he must decide how to reveal it, leading to a heartfelt and romantic ending. She Loves Me is a charming musical comedy about love, identity, and seeing someone for who they truly are.</p>
	<p><b>PETER PAN AND WENDY – FEBRUARY 4-7, 11-14, 2027</b></p> <p>Bold, budding scientist Wendy Darling dreams of earning a Nobel Peace Prize. When Peter Pan arrives at her bedroom window, she takes a leap and leaves finishing school behind, chasing adventure among the stars. Facing down fairies, mermaids, and the dastardly Captain Hook, Wendy, Peter Pan, and their friends discover the power of standing together for what’s right. J.M. Barrie’s classic Peter Pan is reimagined for a new generation of theatergoers as a bright, feminist, anti-colonial, empowering play for all ages.</p>
	<p><b>THE HIDING PLACE – APRIL 8-11, 15-18, 2027</b></p> <p>The Hiding Place tells the remarkable true story of Corrie Ten Boom and her family, whose quiet faith and extraordinary courage stood firm in the face of unimaginable evil. During World War II in Nazi-occupied Netherlands, they risked everything to shelter and protect hundreds of Jewish people, hiding them within the walls of their own home. When their secret was discovered, the family was arrested and ultimately sent to the Ravensbrück concentration camp. Yet even in the darkest of circumstances, this story shines with enduring hope as a powerful testament to the power of forgiveness, the resilience of love, and a light no darkness can overcome.</p>
	<p><b>CINDERELLA – JUNE 9-13, 16-20, 2027</b></p> <p>A heartfelt tale of a girl who, despite her wicked stepsisters and stepmother, pulls herself out of the cinders and finds love with the help of a Fairy Godmother, a carriage, and a glass slipper. Only this time she also tries to change Prince Topher into a better man. A contemporary retelling of the classic and timeless story that’s been loved for generations, the musical showcases Rodgers &amp; Hammerstein’s most beloved songs mixed with a modern, hilarious and romantic book by Tony Award nominee Douglas Carter Beane. Audiences will be swept away by timeless enchantment, magical onstage transformations and love.</p>
	<p><b>DEATH BY CHOCOLATE – AUGUST 5-8, 12-15, 2027</b></p> <p>Members of the newly renovated Meadowbrook Health Resort are dropping like flies, including famed chef Edith Chiles! On the eve of the grand re-opening, it’s up to John Stone, the manager, to find the cause of the crimes and the murderer. Delightfully sarcastic and cynical, Stone finds himself teaming up with Ed Parlor, mystery writer and amateur sleuth, in a wacky race against time. The clues point to a sinister box of chocolates, and the suspects include all the outlandish characters working for the resort.
